Four Experiences By Way Of Example

1. Ministry of Economy and Finances - Mali

In view of strengthening its capacities in strategic management, the Ministry of Economy and Finances of Mali adopted Results-Based Management (RBM) as a tool for managing corporate performance. The services of Focus International were then retained in 2002-2005, namely for the implementation of an integrated capacity building process using Multisoft-SSR as its core vehicle.

The process included :

- ◆ **Staff training** (about 300 people trained) in RBM;
- ◆ Support to the **design of strategic results frameworks** (for 16 organizational units);
- ◆ Support to the **design of results-based work plans, monitoring frameworks and reports**;
- ◆ **Deployment of Multisoft SSR** across the Ministry;
- ◆ **Staff training** on the use and mastering of the system
- ◆ **Ongoing tailor-made help** to operational and strategic units

2. Ministry of Justice - Mali
